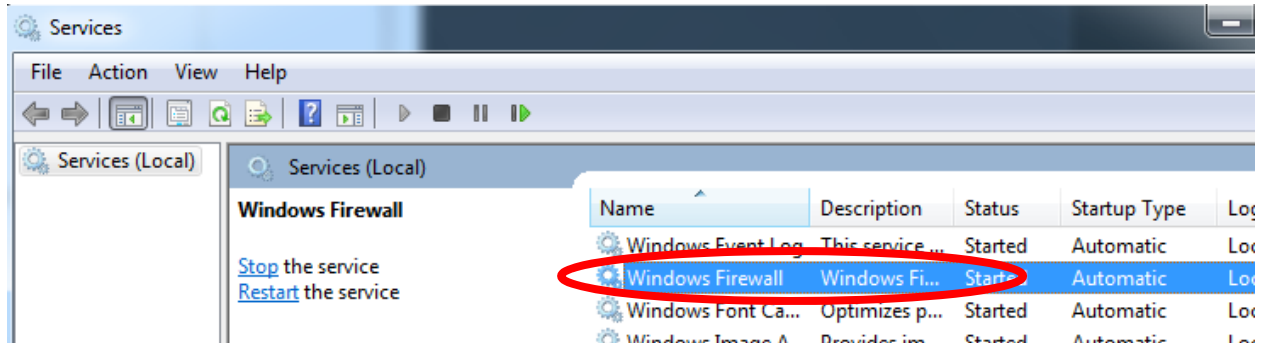


# How to Disable the Windows Firewall

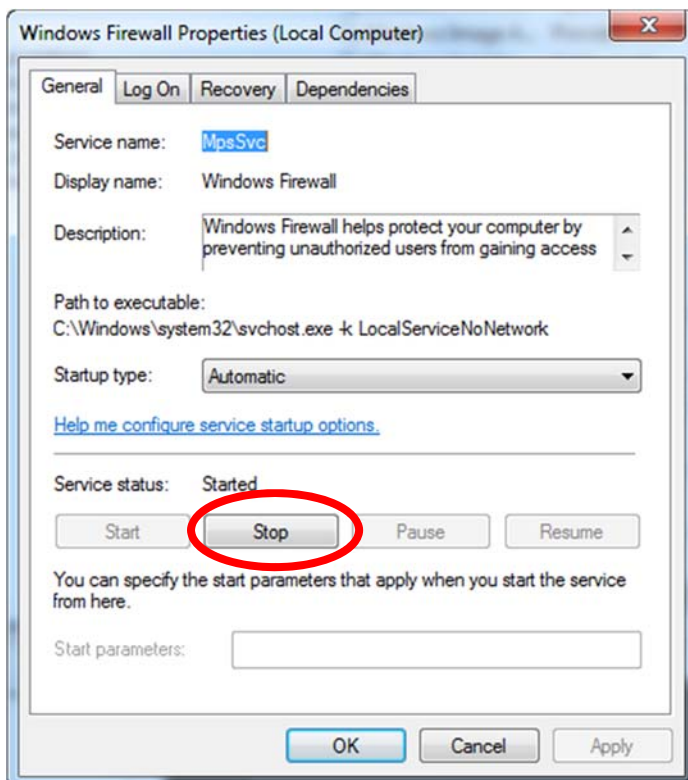

To prevent “arguing” between multiple firewalls, typically it is easiest to disable the Windows firewall

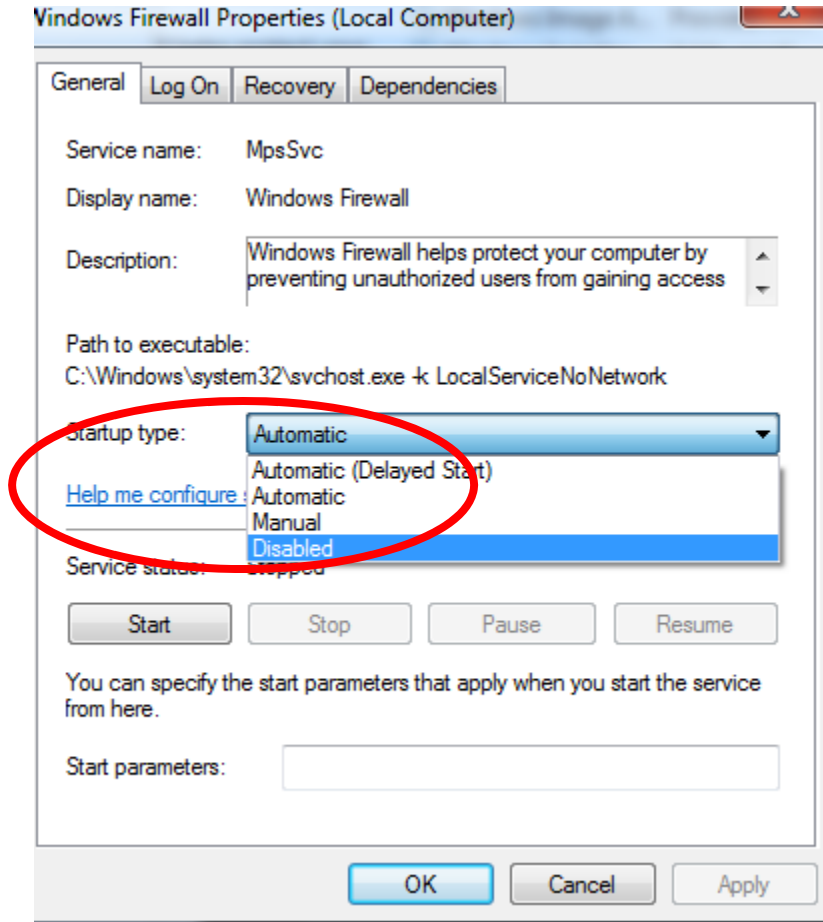
1. Goto **Control Panel**
2. Open **Administrative Tools**
3. Open **SERVICES**
4. Scroll down to WINDOWS FIREWALL



5. Double-click the WINDOWS FIREWALL line entry
6. Click **STOP** on the appearing windows dialog



7. Change the STARTUP TYPE to DISABLED



8. Click APPLY
9. Click OK
10. Process complete.
