HOLY FAMILY PRAYER



HOLY FAMILY NOVENA

The Holy Family is the beginning of countless other holy families.

A novena, in short, is a nine day period of a more intentional focused prayer.

As your family prepares for the celebration of Baptism, you are encouraged to focus more intensely on the Holy Family as a model of holiness for your own family.

Each day will have a small meditation centered on some aspect of the Holy Family. After reading the daily meditation, recite as a family an Our Father, Hail Mary and the Holy Family Prayer (which can be found on the back page).

Mary said "yes" to be the Mother of Jesus.

Joseph said "yes" to protecting and leading his family. Jesus spent his entire life saying "yes" to God, His Father. However, saying "yes" to God's Will requires sacrifice. Lord, help us each individually and as a family say "yes" to Your call. Give us the grace to sacrifice for each other, bear each other's burdens, forgive each other, and help each other out.

DAY 3THE HOLY FAMILY MODELS HUMILITY

God chose to become human in the most humblest of beings...a defenseless baby dependent on his parents. Mary and Joseph then welcomed Him into this world while in a barn and laid him in a manger. These are very humble beginnings indeed, yet full of joy! Lord, help us to be humble and accept our state in life. Teach us to be grateful, to admit our mistakes, to praise others for their success, and to happily serve others.

DAY 4THE HOLY FAMILY AND PRAYER

In Scripture we see the Holy Family participating in prayer and religious customs. Lord, help us be devout in our practice of prayer and the sacramental life. Teach us as your children, to run to you continuously; when we rise and before bed, at meal time, whether at play or work, in joy or sorrow. May we habitually find ourselves at the feet of Jesus.

Each member of the Holy Family did the Will of God, even though at times, those acts of obedience brought uncertainty or suffering (fleeing to Egypt to escape Herod or Christ's passion and death). Lord, help us be obedient to Your call while also encouraging each other to obey God's command. May we be of special assistance to each other when following Your Will is difficult.
